## *Los Angeles, Calif. — Compton Creek Bike Path Year Two — 2010*

### **Los Angeles County Bicycle Coalition Community Support Grant: \$5,000 Award**

The Compton Creek Bike Path and Multi Use Trail passes through the urban residential neighborhoods along the northern stretch of channelized Compton Creek for 2.85 miles, with a separate 1.82-mile section running through the industrial area south of the Artesia freeway to Del Amo in unincorporated Los Angeles County. While these segments of the trail are already in place, there are opportunities to extend and connect the segments to each other as well as regional pathways along the Los Angeles River. The trail system also has potential for improvements in connections and public awareness with the surrounding neighborhoods.



Through advocacy, education and outreach, Los Angeles County Bicycle Coalition (LACBC) brings together the region's diverse bicycling community in a united mission to make the entire Los Angeles area a safe and enjoyable place to ride. LACBC is already involved in healthy living programming and several trail projects in the area, including the Compton Creek Bike Path.
