ADDED TO FUND 1 IN THE FISCAL YEARS 2011, 2016 AND 2021. IN ACCORDANCE

DURING THE YEAR ENDED SEPTEMBER 30, 2018, THE CONSERVANCY ESTABLISHED THE KEITH LAUGHLIN LEGACY ENDOWMENT FUND. THE CONSERVANCY'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS ESTABLISHED THIS FUND TO HONOR THE 18 YEARS OF SERVICE OF ITS PRESIDENT KEITH LAUGHLIN. THE BOARD MADE PERSONAL PLEDGES IN EXCESS OF \$500,000, OF WHICH \$163,250 WAS RESTRICTED IN PERPETUITY.
