# Equitable Transportation Funding and Enhanced Trail Infrastructure

A new poll revealing Baltimore voters' strong support for rebalancing transportation spending priorities and enhancing infrastructure for walking and biking was released today by Rails to Trails Conservancy (RTC) and the Central Maryland Transportation Alliance (CMTA). The findings highlight a clear preference for a more equitable allocation of funds across pedestrian/bike infrastructure, public transit and highways, moving away from the current budget which predominantly supports highways.





\$23.52	Fixing and maintaining roads and highways
